Clinical Pharmacists Wanted

Two Pharmacists are needed to work full-time or part-time beginning in October 2011.

As a pharmacist working in this Family Health Team, you will:

- Provide individual patient assessments to identify, prevent, and resolve drug-related problems
- Develop the practice based on the needs of the FHT

To apply, you must:

- be able to work in an interdisciplinary team environment
- be able to prioritize and be flexible in a very active work environment
- demonstrate expertise in practicing pharmaceutical care
- have a Bachelor's degree in pharmacy
- be registered in Part A of the Ontario College of Pharmacists
- have completed a community or hospital residency or have equivalent clinical experience in either setting*
